

## FEEDBACK FROM SAINT IMPLEMENTATION BOARD 18/4/07

1. Action tracker – copies to distribute
2. Saint compliance by Schools – as part of the HUB review, Alison Darnbrough will be doing a business processes review but it was agreed it would be useful for an update on Saint compliance to be done before this.
3. User Forum minutes – it was reported that these were now felt to be more comprehensive and easier to follow. They are also available on the web.
4. Progression and award – Chris Toft reported that she was reviewing PIT codes with the ASAs and the plan was that these would be made easier to use and understand prior to the exam boards this summer. It is planned for the revised BRAD report to be available for the supplementary period as the summer boards are mainly first attempts.
5. Business Objects licences - these are needed for the new Exam Board Reporting documentation and a certain number will be allocated to each School (based on number of students). I understand that admin staff who are due to attend the exam boards will get a licence but if more licences are needed, Schools will need to buy these themselves.
6. Switching marks on and off in eVision. Marks will be switched off on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the exam periods. Individual schools/departments should inform the Saint team when they would like this facility switching back on for their particular areas. There will be a default date but the Saint team would rather stagger this turning back on, to avoid system crashes.
7. Admissions – discussion re hot fixes and whether they should be applied around/during clearing. The Upgrade Sub-Committee will be reconvened to discuss this.

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
