

Data Protection Statement

You and the University of Bradford

Information contained on the University of Bradford Enrolment Form and other information held by the University, collected from yourself or others (such as UCAS), is processed, analysed and stored both in electronic and paper format by the University of Bradford for various administrative, academic, statistical, and health and safety reasons during your time at the University. This enables us to carry out our administrative and statutory functions.

A digital photo of yourself will also be collected and stored electronically by the University. The purpose of such is for use on the University Student Identification and Registration Card. This card also forms your NUS and University of Bradford Union Card. You should note that the image might be used by your School/Department, as well as central administrative units for Health and Safety and Identification purposes.

Again, under the Data Protection Act 1998 you have the right to a copy of the data held about you by the University of Bradford, for a small fee. Any concerns about, or objections to the use of data for these purposes should be directed in writing to The Registrar and Secretary, University of Bradford, Richmond Road, Bradford, BD7 1DP.
