

'What to expect from your appointment with the Educational Psychologist'

Once it has been decided that you would benefit from an assessment. you can expect the following:

- The Disability Service will arrange an appointment
- You will be given a date and a time
- The appointment will last approximately 1½ - 2 hours.

The assessment will determine whether your difficulties are a result of Specific Learning Difficulties, such as dyslexia or dyspraxia.

In your appointment:

You will be able to discuss your difficulties with the psychologist in confidence. You will be asked to complete some exercises which assess a range of skills including; underlying ability, vocabulary, reading, writing, spelling and memory.

IMPORTANT:

The psychologist may offer you some initial feedback at the end of the assessment, but you will not get a final 'diagnosis' until you get the full report. This might take 4-6 weeks to complete.

The psychologist might also suggest that you need some extra support or adjustments, but we will not be able to arrange this until we receive your report.

We will contact you when we receive it and offer you an appointment with a Disability Adviser. At this appointment you will be able to discuss the findings and explore the next steps. If you have any queries, please contact the Disability Service
