By car: Bradford is connected to the national motorway network via the M62 and the M606.

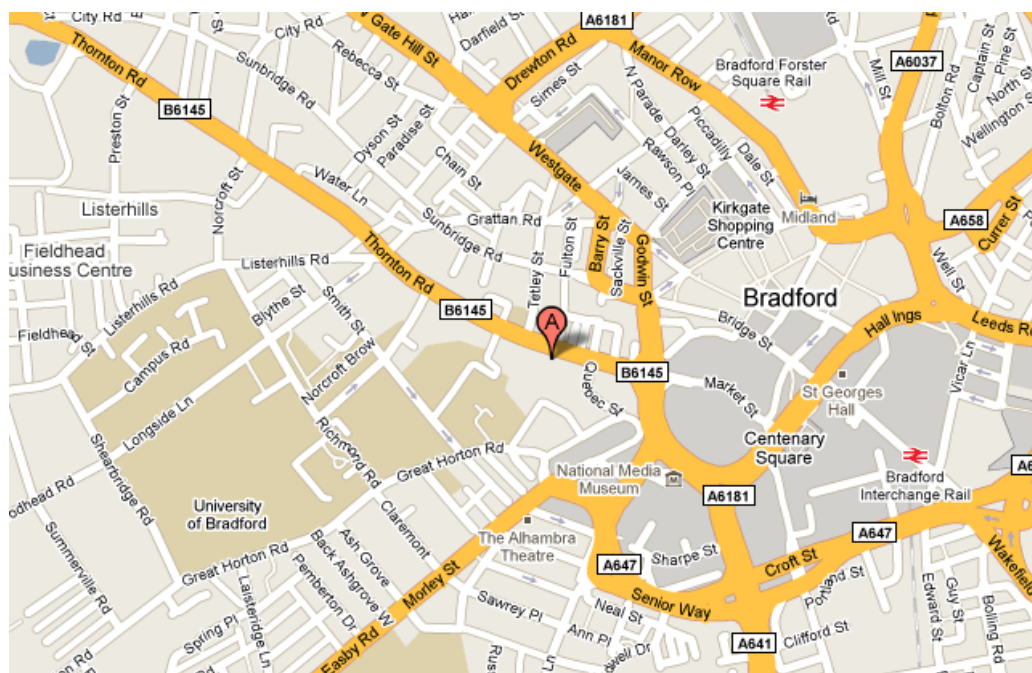
Car Parking on Campus

The University car parking policy requires permits to be displayed on the motor vehicles of all staff, students and visitors who park in University car parks during the period of 9.00 am to 5.30pm, Monday to Friday. Due to the limited parking space, visitors are encouraged to use the *Shearbridge Green car park*. Its entrance is off Great Horton Road, next to the 'UNIQUE' Sports and Amenities centre. You will need to collect a parking permit from the Richmond Reception staff. It should be noted that parking is very limited and visitors are encouraged to come by public transport wherever possible. Richmond Reception Desk: 01274 23 4894. *Please note that spaces cannot be reserved or parking guaranteed, although parking permits may be issued in advance. We may not always be able to supply permits for daytime events taking place during the week in term time. *

Car Parking off Campus

By train:

The nearest railway stations are Bradford Interchange station and Forster Square station. They both have extensive rail links, though many involve changing at Leeds. The Interchange is where you will probably arrive. National Rail Enquiries - www.nationalrail.co.uk. A taxi service (Great Horton Taxis - 01274 521672) is available from Bradford Interchange station to the Richmond Building (approximately 3 minutes ride & costing about £4.00).

Free City Bus:

Operated by Metro and Bradford Council, Bradford FreeCityBus service connects key locations around the city centre. The buses run every ten minutes from 7am to 7pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 5.30pm on Saturdays.
