



As of 4th April this year, the Consumer Financial Education Body (CFEB), formerly part of the FSA, became the **Money Advice Service***, the new statutory organisation providing free, universal money advice to the UK public.

The new service is paid for by the levy placed on the financial services sector. It is independent of government.
