The module will equip the trainee Nursing Associate with knowledge to provide safe, compassionate and effective person centred care in a range of settings.

Outline Syllabus
Human development; body systems; homeostasis; anatomy and physiology; behavioural science; anxiety; depression; cardiac diseases; dementia; stroke; providing information to patients, families and carers to support management of health conditions; active listening; clear, caring verbal and non-verbal communication; questioning; checking understanding and clarification; person centred care models; escalation of concerns and seeking help; assertiveness; nutrition; supporting sleep, privacy and dignity; documenting and reporting care; monitoring effectiveness of care and reporting changes; symptom management; capacity and best interests; learning disabilities; reasonable adjustments; safeguarding.

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

Students will develop understanding and application of their knowledge through the use of lectures and seminars, in a blended approach involving face to face learning and online synchronous and asynchronous activities which will be evidence based and research informed

Face to face lectures will enhance the student experience and provide an interactive learning experience (LO 1-5).

Practical Classes and Workshops: Practical sessions consist of opportunities to enhance acquisition of nursing procedures and communication skills (LO 2,3,4).

Online Synchronous Seminars: Where there is no student advantage to travel (LO 1, 5)

Learning Objects interaction: Interaction with specific packages online. (LO 3,6)

Clinical Placement: Unchanged. (LO 1-6)

Tutorials: Online or face to face depending on student needs.(LO4).
