- Over 100 students and staff completed the survey
- Bananas and Chocolate are the most commonly bought FT items
- 85% think it is important that the University takes action to use and promote FT products
- Purchases directly influenced by ethical standards of the product
  - 43% bought in the last month
  - 16% never buy
